Prime Minister announced new rules

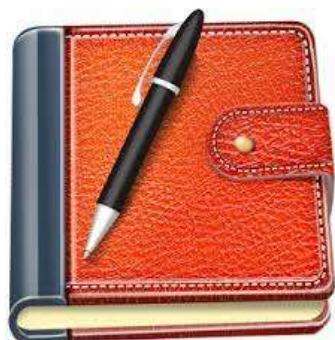
- Indoor gatherings now limited to 200 people
