
Many thanks for setting up the bubble system to keep us safe during lockdown. In Jesus name.

The committee is looking at a new home for ADCF.




Quiz answers



You can see this in the books of the bible eg. Ephesians and Corinthians. Paul then would write about challenges or topics that were happening in their community of their time.

God taught us that we need to come to Him (God) for help when we are facing difficult times,


When you have a problem, 1st.sign/ talk to God. Pray to Him and ask Him for his help and that he show us, lead us and help us (guidance!).
