


The AGM reports will be sent to all members shortly and we will contact you about the AGM meeting date in the future.

4 Epaphroditus was with Paul (in Rome) and he became so sick he was near death, now he is better and Paul is going to send him back to the Philippians.



A great lesson learned from the Bible. Paul tells us this in Philippians 3 v 12-14.

I try as hard as I can to reach the goal before me. ¹⁴ I keep trying to reach the goal and get the prize.... Holy Bible, English version for Deaf.

Looking back in the past is called negative continuity and it does not help you keep your focus of Jesus. You can see all your bad things, sins and mistakes when you look back at the past.

A better way is always look to the future; this is called positive continuity. Keeping your eyes and mind focused on Jesus will help you avoid the traps of bad things.
