Phyllis had worked as a florist, running a florist shop for many years with, I believe, her mum. She always loved flowers and it had been hard for her to give up this much loved work.

She married Robin Sherrock, an electrician and inventor. They lived on the North Shore, which she also loved. She was an artist and a good one at that.

During the time I met her, Phyllis began knitting. She knitted so many, many lovely toys, creating very fine details, clothing, little flowers and vegetables – I remember rabbits with tiny carrots – even seats

for her animals to sit on. Especially she knitted for people in need, many nurses buying her toys to give to children who



were in hospital. They were truly beautiful and amazing. I still have some myself.



When she

needed some extra help, I supported her move into the Everill Orr rest home, where she and Mere got together. They loved their time, going into New Lynn shopping mall, hopping on the electric scooters and travelling all around together, getting up to all sorts of mischief.

Hi everyone

We are now part way through 2023 and I have been thinking about the laws and rules given to us by the Prime Minister and our country.

Remember the laws that God gave Moses on Mount Horeb? These are 1<sup>st</sup> written in Exodus 20 1 – 20 and are called the 10 commandments. These commandments are written lots of times all through the Bible, even Jesus talked about them. Someone worked out the are over 35 million laws (lots and lots, a really big number) around the world to enforce (put into force) the 10 Commandments given to use by God. This social will be moved to another month this year. We will let you know when.


