1 We should stop doing sin, we died from our old sinful ways when we accepted Christ Jesus as our saviour. (the temptation is sin is still there but it does not control us or have power over us like before we accepted Jesus into our life, bad habits and addictions can a type of sin).

2 Christ died on the cross for our sin. Jesus has the power to defeat sin, we need to pray to him to help us overcome our sinful selves so sin does not control us.

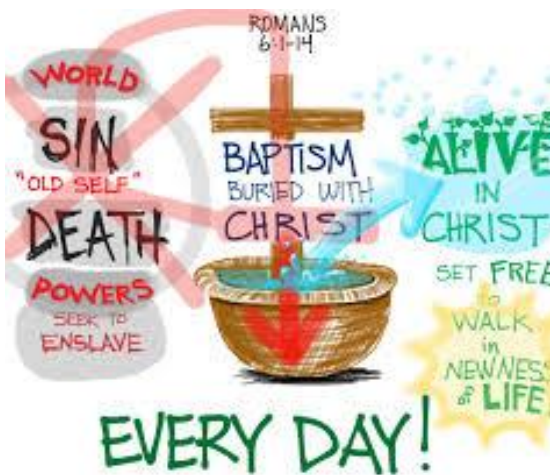
3 The rules Paul gives to stop serving sin

- Don't offer parts of your body to serve sin.
- Don't use your bodies as things to do evil with.

4 When we are part of Gods family, we have God's grace, this does not mean we can keep on doing sin like before we were baptised just because God will forgive us. We have a new Master when we get baptised in Christ and that Master is God / Jesus / Holy Spirit. Slaves and servants obey their Master and we (Christians) are to obey our Master too and our Master says to stop doing sin.

5 Sin bring spiritual death to your soul. Your soul will not live after you die.

6 When we live for God, when our body dies, our soul goes to live with Jesus.
