

Lynette (Michelle's Mum) – pray for healing after her recent surgery.




COVID virus- pray that they find a solution for this big problem.

Message from Glenn, our chairperson

Hi everyone

Continuing to look at Proverbs 16. We will look at Verse 5 today.

"The Lord hates people who are proud and He will punish them, that is sure." **P**roverbs 16 verse 5

<u>What is pride or being proud?</u> Pride could be that inner voice that whispers loudly – "My way is best", or "My way or the highway" - this is a common saying in English language that means 'do it my way or go away because my way is the only way to do it.

<u>Is this how God really wants us to be?</u> **NO** - Having pride is believing we can live without God's help or leadership. Only when you get rid of pride in your lives, can God guide you to be what He has planned for you.

<u>How to overcome pride?</u> Pray, asking God for His guidance. Focus on God and others, not yourself.

You can also see more about pride (or being proud) in The Bible - Proverbs 11 v 2 and Proverbs 16 verse 18
