

Message from Glenn, our chairperson

Did you know that King Solomon wrote most of the Proverbs early in his time as king. He was known as the wise king. He also wrote Ecclesiastes and Song of Songs.

I have been reading Proverbs 16 verse 1-15 (the Bible quiz is about these verses). We will look at some of these Proverbs in the coming months. Let's look at verses 1 and 9 (they are similar or the same, depending on which bible you read), about people making plans and God making the final decision.

I think about the time I planned to go sailing on my boat. On the day, the weather was awful – windy and rainy. God had other plans for me.

Can you think of a time when you planned something and the plans had to change?

– does this mean we shouldn't make plans because the final outcome is in God's hands? No, it doesn't, we still need to plan, remember, we need to ask for guidance as we plan and if things change – maybe God has a better plan for you.
