
This year, 3 of the 4 committee members retire, some have been on the committee for many years (like 20), we hope they will be replaced.

Terry M and Michelle S met at Pinesong Cafe for a lovely lunch.


The weather was quite yuck (raining and windy) so we were happy to be inside.
